At Coolmine Therapeutic Community (TC) we provide a range of quality community, day and residential addiction treatment services for the marginalised in Irish society. Our vision is that everyone should have the opportunity to overcome addiction and to lead a fulfilled and productive life.

Established in 1973 as the first drug and alcohol treatment centre in Ireland, we witnessed the serious impact intergenerational drug and alcohol use has created for family life and on communities. In 2020 we provided over 12,000+ support contacts through a range of quality community and residential services to empower men and women and their families overcome addiction and support long term recovery.

We operate the only mother and child residential facility in Ireland together with a residential facility for men. Our outreach services engage with vulnerable populations such as homeless people and ethnic minority groups. Our Day services offer a drug-free day programme based on TC principles. A significant expansion of services is underway with new services coming on stream this past year in Limerick, Cork and Kerry.

RECOVERY THROUGH NATURE

While our primary responsibility is to provide our Clients with a safe environment to support their recovery from drug and alcohol addiction, we also offer integrated therapeutic programmes such as 'Recovery through Nature' (RTN). This is recognised as effective therapy in aiding and supporting formal addiction counselling. We have been operating RTN projects since 2014 and have witnessed the positive impact they have on Client's wellbeing and in their personal recovery. As a result of COVID-19, we suspended our RTN projects in March 2020. We are keen to re-structure our existing horticultural programmes to also provide the opportunity to produce from garden to table for consumption in our residential communities.

This will provide Clients with the opportunity to engage with nature while undergoing their therapeutic residential treatment. It really makes a difference by bringing structure to their day and offering the opportunity to acquire new skills and a sense of achievement. Clients will take responsibility for their cultivation of their plot and output for consumption by the Community, and in time for supply to local Farmers markets and donating produce to local charities.
