# LEANDRA O'MALLEY CHILDCARE MANAGER

Hi Everyone,

I am delighted to take some time to share with you a little around myself and my role here in Coolmine. I was appointed Coolmine's Childcare Manager in August 2021. Since then, I have seen the change, growth and inspiring work that takes place in Coolmine on a daily basis. It is a privilege be part of an organisation that shares a strong ethos around breaking down barriers for people suffering from addiction and ultimately, improving family outcomes.

In my short time here, it is apparent that Coolmine is committed to providing a continuum of care to our clients. Holding family, quality of life and relationships at its core is what makes Coolmine a unique place to work. I have worked in the Early Years sector for over 20 years, working in the private, public and non-profit sectors, both here and in the UK. However, Coolmine is a special and unique service that professionals, many individuals, organisations and groups come together to break the generational cycle of addition. House, mothers accessing Ashleigh programmes can feel secure knowing that their

child is being cared for and nurtured in our onsite Early Years Pre-school and baby room. Our qualified and dedicated staff work in partnership with parents and other agencies to delivery excellent care, education and stability to the children in Ashleigh House. Our service provides high quality early learning and care to children – whilst providing evidence-based parenting support to our mothers, through the facilitation of our Parents Under Pressure Program (PUP). Our experienced childcare team value time to play and provide the children with ample opportunities to play, be creative, express themselves socially and emotionally, in a safe and nurturing environment – whilst providing evidence-based parenting support to our mothers, framing 'Recovery through the lens of the child'.

Our work provides us with the opportunity to break the generational cycle of addiction, through working with the whole family community – mothers, fathers, and their children. When considering childcare philosophies, the proverb "it takes village to raise a child" really stands out and encapsulates the vision we hold, here in Coolmine.

Our childcare team has grown during the past year, with extra childcare provisions being delivered in the Mid-west, through our Drop-in day services for children in Mahon House. Our new Community Day Service in Limerick supports vulnerable women, pregnant women and women with young children. We plan to establish over the coming 12 months a residential addiction treatment programme for women, with a 15-20 bed facility together with on-site creche facilities - similar to Ashleigh House!

I have always been passionate about delivering quality early years experiences to children and removing barriers for them to reap the benefits from the positive outcomes quality Early Years Education and Care can bring about.

Luckily for me, I get to see much of the organisation, its services and the fantastic work that happens every day... I look forward to creating more meaningful work, alongside the committed and dedicated childcare team!















## **ADDEY & PA'S STORY**

"I sat in the Draíocht three years ago and I saw my sister and her partner graduate from Coolmine. It was great to see how far they came in their lives, and how Coolmine really worked for them – that's what gave me the motivation to give it my all, and change my life.

"I came into Ashleigh House in 2019, and it has been a long three years to get to where I am today. But it was worth every minute of it. While I was just two months into my programme, my partner Pa could already see a difference in me. He went into the Lodge and started his recovery journey. It was very exciting that both of us were on this recovery journey together, and wanted a better life. The support we got as a couple here in Coolmine was second to none, and we will be forever grateful for that.

"Before coming to Ashleigh House I was on a very bad road, and had been for most of my life. I am

back stronger than anything and I've learnt a lot in my journey with Coolmine. My life is so good today: I have just recently finished Community Addiction Studies Level 5 and I plan to go to college and do a degree in addiction studies.

"I love my life today and I will be forever thankful to the staff in Coolmine" - Addey
