The appointee will report into an internal lead within Coolmine and will be supported by a well-established Research Advisory Group. In addition, the appointee will work with Principal Investigators to deliver on specific projects.

Key responsibilities

- Design, lead, manage and complete all research projects and initiatives from inception through to publication in line with best practice guidelines
- Establish strong research collaborations with third parties including third-level institutions, NGOs, and government sectors
- Summarise project results, prepare progress reports, articles and presentations
- Monitor all research outputs and budgetary spending, ensuring projects are delivered to the agreed deadlines and budgets
- Ensure all research projects have a strong focus on outcomes to inform Coolmine TCs evidence-based approach
- Produce published research with high impact value
- Identify and secure funding streams to support on-going research within the organisation
- Collaborate with Coolmine TC management team to ensure timely research/ evaluations are produced to inform policy/ practice/ management/ stakeholders
- Support the research and information needs of other Coolmine TC departments
- Produce research that contributes to the overall assessment of Coolmine's impact from a financial, social and societal perspective (i.e. Cost benefit analysis)
- Attend and present at conferences and dissemination events relevant to current and future research in Coolmine

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- Deliver research supporting and developing Coolmine TCs research capacity in collaboration with our internal Research Advisory Group (RAG)
- Assist with preparation of all educational and training workshops and knowledge exchange (KE) strategies
- Coordinate external research proposals in line with research policy/ objectives and ethical requirements (i.e. GDPR)

- Masters degree (QQI Level 9) is required in Social/Health Science or a cognate discipline with relevant experience of the drug and alcohol sector is essential
- Ph.D. degree (QQI Level 10) is desired but not required

- Excellent knowledge of issues related to addiction, homelessness, social exclusion, and social policies in addiction and homelessness areas
- Capacity and confidence to manage multiple ongoing projects
- Demonstrable experience in innovative research leadership
- Have excellent research and data analytics skills with advanced level expertise in relevant statistical programmes
- Have a track history in grant/funding acquisition
- Strong qualitative and quantitative analytical skills, including experience using software packages such as SPSS and NVivo

- Ability to communicate effectively with colleagues and stakeholders in a constructive and approachable manner
